



## The MYO Challenger League 2024 Season is Open for Registration!

### Who is the MYO Challenger League?

The MYO Challenger League gives boys and girls with physical and developmental disabilities the opportunity to play baseball like their peers. Players will learn baseball skills, how to work together as a team, as well as make lasting memories.

### Who can play in the MYO Challenger League?

Players in the league come from the city of Mason and surrounding communities including areas of Warren, Clermont, and Northern Hamilton counties. You do not need to be a resident of Mason to play.

### What is the age limit?

MYO Challenger League accepts players between the ages of 5 through young adult. Athletes are placed in the minor (5-11 years old), major (12-16 years old), or senior (17+ years old) league based on age and skill. If needed, the players are matched with a buddy.

### When does the League play?

MYO Challenger typically plays on Saturdays starting at the end of April. 2024 schedules may change slightly depending on the completion of the Adaptive Ball Fields at Makino Park, including the addition of practices.

### What is the cost to play?

This season the cost to play is \$30 per player.
